	Does the property stated on the Schedule of Property to be Distributed in Kind (Page two of Form 10.0) have an adequate description? Is the property being distributed shown on the Schedule of Assets (Form 6.1)
	Is the document typewritten with no white-out?
	Did the fiduciary sign the application?
	Are there consents from the surviving spouse and/or other interested parties?
	Is the item to be distributed part of the residuary, if there is a will?
	Look at the schedule of assets; is there sufficient cash to balance out the other heirs under the will or under the statute of descent and distribution?
	If claims have been filed, have they been satisfied or is there sufficient cash on hand to satisfy the claims?
